True - They can swim across rivers and lakes.

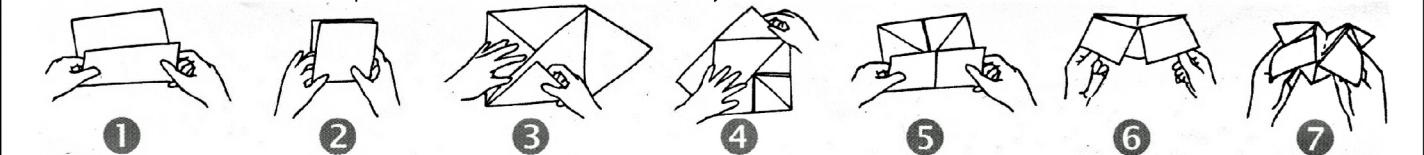


True or false: All black bears are black in colour.

FOLDING INSTRUCTION: (NOTE- Tear or cut these instructions before beginning!)

1. Fold the paper neatly in half and then in half again.
2. Undo the folds and flatten out the paper. Turn the paper over, with the writing facing downwards, and fold in each corner so the four points meet in the centre.
3. Flip the paper over. Again, fold in each corner so that the four points meet in the centre.
4. Fold the square in half, making a rectangle, with the open flaps facing down. The writing should be right-side up.
5. Slide both index fingers and thumbs under each of the four outer flaps.
6. Pinching your fingers together, push the top corners of the flaps toward the centre. Poke down in the centre to help form the shape.
